Go - Go Golf Descriptions

- 🐼 Go - Go Golf is a fun activity introducing students to the basic skills required for playing Golf.
- 🐼 Students are given the opportunity to learn, play & experience Golf.
- 🐼 Students will be required to use the following Golf Equipment:-
 - 🐼 7 - Iron Golf Clubs
 - 🐼 Putters
- 🐼 The Golf Balls used for Go - Go Golf are Rubber Imitation Golf Balls similar to Squash Balls.

Age Suitability

- 🐼 12 - 18 year olds.

Staff Ratio

(Remember Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff cannot be considered as part of your Staff : Student Ratio at any stage during your Blackwood Experience.)

- 🐼 1:6 - leaders/teachers/adults to campers (a minimum of 2 Visiting Staff must be accompany Go - Go Golf)

- 🐼 Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff have previous experience in preparing, implementing, leading and reviewing Go - Go Golf.
- 🐼 They are confident of their own experience & ability to safely implement Go - Go Golf.
- 🐼 Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff have experience in Go - Go Golf.
- 🐼 Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff are aware of the intricacies involved in implementing the Go - Go Golf including, but not limited to:-
 - 🐼 Equipment required
 - 🐼 Students causing problems during the activity
 - 🐼 Risk Management & Emergency Procedures
- 🐼 All other Logistical requirements for Go - Go Golf.


- 🐼 Must have previous experience in supervising groups in outdoor recreation activities.

Student Participant Experience










- 🐼 Ability & Willingness to safely be involved in Go - Go Golf.






Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Responsibilities

-  To ensure the Activity is appropriate for the age, ability & experience of the visiting students.
-  To safely & confidently implement Go - Go Golf.
-  Take responsibility for the technical and related safety of participants engaged in the activity.
-  Confirming Weather conditions with Group Leaders prior to preparing the Go - Go Golf Activity.
-  Briefing participants about the nature and purpose of the activity, about potential hazards and appropriate safety procedures and instructions to be followed.





Group Leaders Responsibilities

-  The Group Leader will be responsible for the supervision and behaviour of campers on the activity, at all times and for first aid.
-  Assessing first aid requirements, identifying campers at risk
e.g. asthma and appointing the first aider
-  Informing other Visiting Staff of their roles in the behaviour, supervision and instruction of campers.
-  Monitoring the welfare and fitness of Campers and other Visiting Staff.
-  Checking the suitability of clothing and equipment carried by Campers and other Visiting Staff.
-  Undertaking a head count prior to, during and after the Go - Go Golf Activity.
-  Implementing sun safe strategies for all Campers & Visiting Staff.
-  Recording all incidents - including near misses - on the Incident Notification Form and / or patient Care Report and advising the Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre inc. Staff and their School Principals.
-  Assuming all Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff Responsibilities - as listed above - if leading the Activity without Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff support.


















Visiting Staff Responsibilities

-  To carry out tasks as directed by the Group Leader and / or Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff.
-  These may include - but are not limited to:-
 -  Monitoring the welfare and fitness of campers;
 -  Assisting the Group Leader and Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff;
 -  First aid responsibility;
 -  The supervision and behaviour of campers; and
 -  Adhering to the safety rules.

Participant Responsibilities

-  Adhering to the safety rules and directions of:-
 -  Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff
 -  Group Leader
 -  Visiting Staff

First Aid Requirements

- 🐼 The Group Leader **MUST** carry a first aid kit at all times.
- 🐼 There **MUST** be a qualified first aider within the visiting staff - not necessarily the Group Leader.
- 🐼 Insect repellent and stingoos is a good idea.

Safety Briefing & Emergency Response

- 🐼 **DO NOT Swing the Golf Club:-**
 - 🐼 When NOT instructed to swing your club;
 - 🐼 When someone is standing behind you;
 - 🐼 Directly at anyone else in the Group - Students & Staff Members; and
 - 🐼 When people are collecting their Golf Balls from the Oval.
- 🐼 **DO NOT hit any Golf Balls until a Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff Member has blown a Whistle**
- 🐼 **DO NOT Run**
- 🐼 **DO NOT disturb others who are engaged in the Activity**
- 🐼 **Once you have hit all your Golf Balls:-**
 - 🐼 Place your Golf Club on the ground; and
 - 🐼 Sit down until everyone has finished hitting their Golf balls.
- 🐼 **DO NOT walk onto the Oval to collect your Golf Balls until a Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc. Staff Member has blown a Whistle**
- 🐼 **When you go onto the Oval to collect your Golf Balls you DO NOT carry your Golf Club.**
- 🐼 **IF THERE IS AN EMERGENCY SITUATION EVERYONE MUST STOP AND FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF BLACKWOOD SPECIAL SCHOOLS OUTDOOR EDUCATION CENTRE Inc. STAFF / GROUP LEADER / EMERGENCY SERVICES**

Activity Notes

- 🐼 **Anyone Leading Go - Go Golf through Blackwood Special Schools Outdoor Education Centre Inc MUST BE:-**
 - 🐼 Familiar with Go - Go Golf
 - 🐼 Familiar with the Go - Go Golf Activity Safety Briefing
 - 🐼 Familiar with Emergency & Risk Management Plans
 - 🐼 Currently 1st Aid Level 2 Qualified
- 🐼 **Everyone MUST BE checked to ensure they have appropriate gear for Go - Go Golf**
- 🐼 **Constantly check the health and wellbeing of all members of the group**

Environmental Considerations

- 🐼 **Groups MUST implement Minimal Impact Practices throughout every Go - Go Golf Game**
- 🐼 **These include but are not limited to:-**
 - 🐼 If you carried it in, you carry it out
 - 🐼 Don't feed or leave food for the animals
 - 🐼 Leave the Go - Go Golf Course better than you found it
 - 🐼 Always walk on the tracks and established paths
- 🐼 **Keep the noise to a minimum**
